The meeting was called to order by Temporary Chair Don Davidson at 7:00PM.

New Business

Don Davidson presented a video describing a 'quick connect' alternative power transition.

Rick Black explained the steps homeowners can take to install a generator powered energy source. His presentation included determining their residential use including the length of power supply needed, the number and type of appliances to be powered, how much energy is needed, and what is their budget. Questions included what the Town codes for installing alternative power sources are—a future presentation might be scheduled to answer this question.

Mark Stamos presented an update on election for permanent Directors will be held May 26th. Voting will be in-person only, and voters must be members in good standing (dues paid with membership card). Ballots will be counted at the close of the meeting. Results will be announced at the meeting and posted on the WRAP website (www.wraprangely.com)
